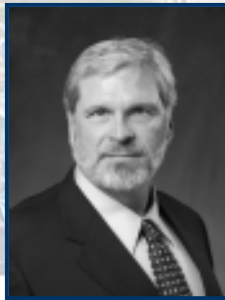

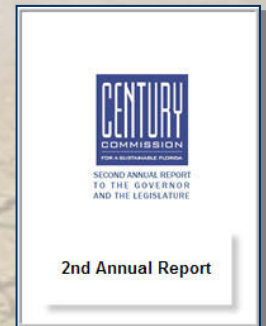


Overview of the Century Commission for a Sustainable Florida

- 15 Members Appointed by Governor and Legislature
- Charged with Establishing a Long-Term Vision for Florida (Next 25-50 Years)
- Our Mission

 - Develop a Shared Image for our Developed & Natural Areas
 - Focus on Essential State Interests
 - Serve as a Repository for Exemplary Community Building Ideas
 - Develop an Annual Report
